Enrollment Requirements (Based upon FAA Commercial Pilot License):

- Student must be at least 18 years of age
- Student must possess a valid passport
- Student must be able to read, speak, write, and understand the English language
- Student must pass a medical examination from an FAA certified examiner.

We will accept students into the course who are at least 17½ years of age, as they will reach their 18th birthday before the completion of the course.
